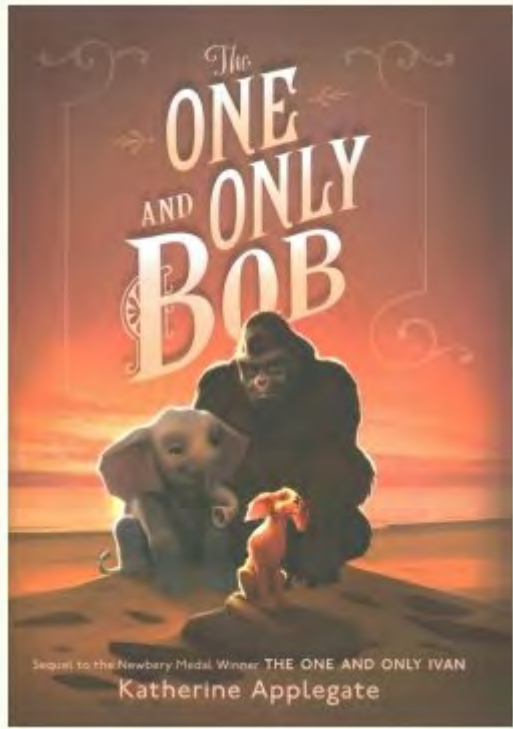

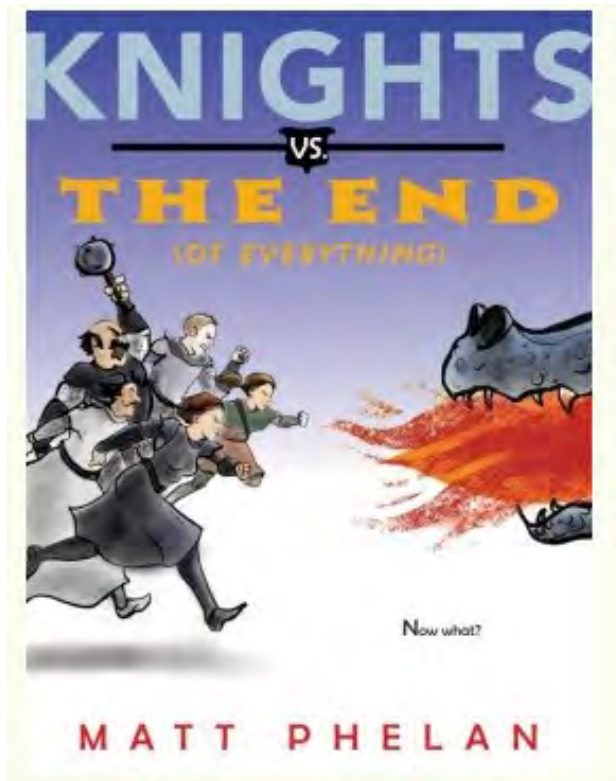
Give your opinion of the book. Did you like it or not and why?

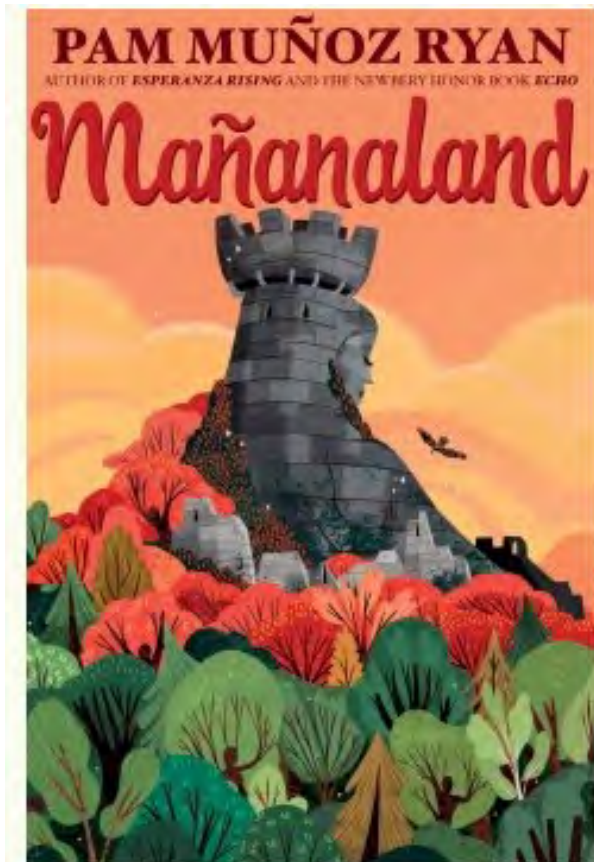
Give your opinion of the book. Did you like it or not and why?

Give your opinion of the book. Did you like it or not and why?

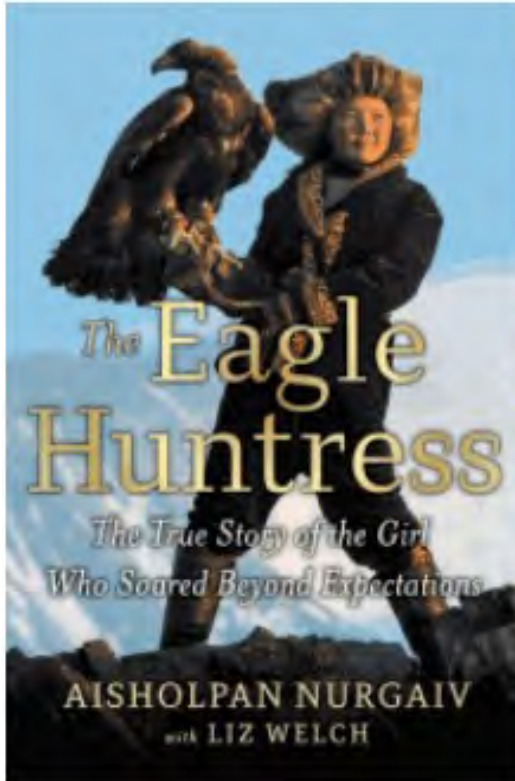
It is an interesting read. It was hooking but also hard to follow. Certain parts were extremely confusing. Only drawback is that the book is practically a copy/spin-off
